Some cows in Malta sleep on mattresses and get played music to produce more milk.

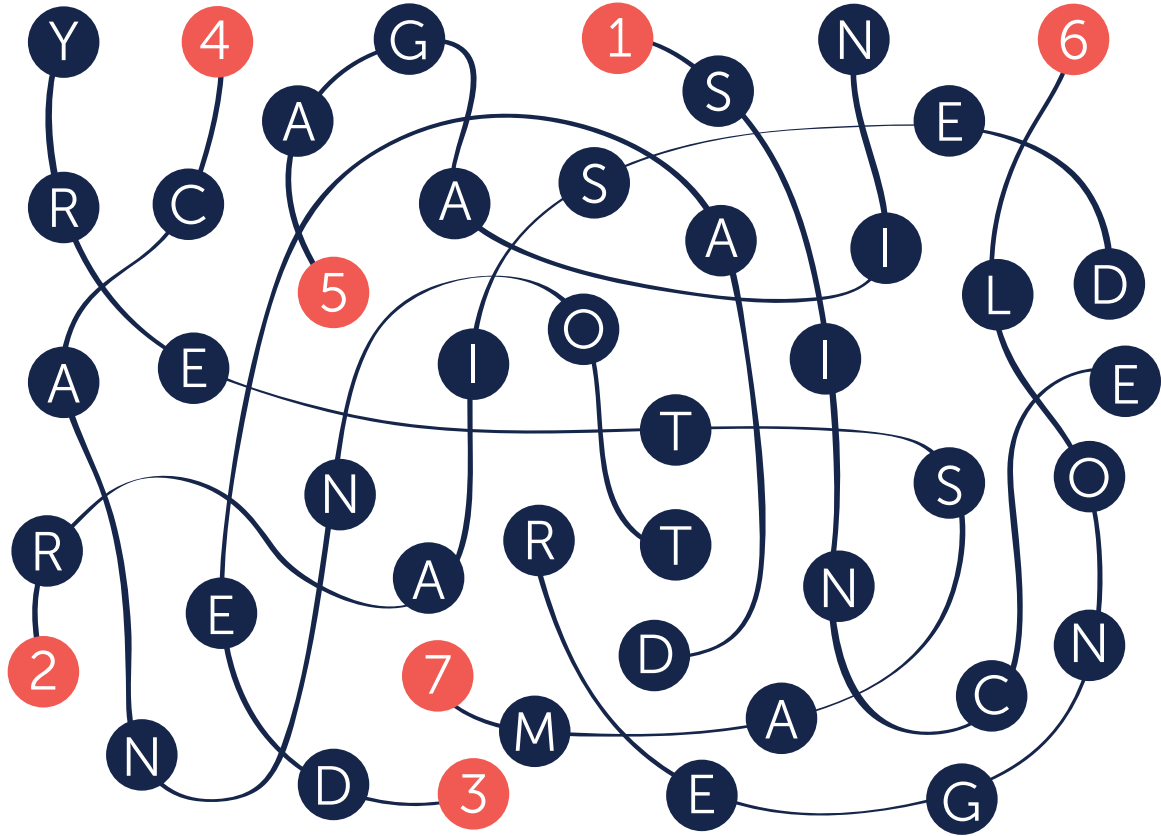


Fun fact:
